RE-ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING OF THE BIG STONE COUNTY BOARD January 6, 2009

Commissioner Brent Olson and newly elected Commissioners Walter Wulff and Joe Berning were sworn in by County Attorney Bill Watson in the Courthouse Rotunda.

The Big Stone County Board of Commissioners met in the Commissioner's Room at 8:30 AM on Tuesday, January 6, 2009, Vice Chairman Olson called the meeting to order with Commissioners Sandberg, Berning, Wulff and Athey present. Also present were Mike Swenson of the Ortonville Independent, County Attorney Bill Watson, and County Auditor Michelle Knutson. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Upon call for nominations for Board Chairman, motion by Athey, seconded by Sandberg and carried to nominate Commissioner Olson. Following 3 calls for nominations, motion by Athey, seconded by Sandberg and carried to cast a unanimous ballot for Commissioner Olson for Chairman. Chairman Olson then called for nominations for Vice Chairman. Motion by Athey, seconded by Berning and carried to nominate Commissioner Sandberg. Following 3 calls for nominations, motion by Athey, seconded by Wulff and carried to cast a unanimous ballot for Commissioner Sandberg for Vice Chairman.

Motion by Sandberg, seconded by Athey and carried to approve the minutes of the December 30th regular meeting.

Motion by Athey, seconded by Berning and carried to approve the agenda with noted addition.

The bids received from the Ortonville Independent and the Northern Star for publishing those notices as legally required were reviewed. Motion by Athey, seconded by Wulff and carried to accept the bid and surety bond of the Ortonville Independent as the official newspaper of the County for 2009. The Northern Star will publish second notices as required by law.

Attorney Watson reported that no resolution is needed by the Board to implement the new Aggregate Tax rates for 2009 per MS 298.75.

Attorney Watson reported that he received notice that the decision on the petition for post conviction relief has been petitioned for discretionary review by the Supreme Court.

Motion by Sandberg, seconded by Wulff and carried to adopt the following resolutions as presented by County Engineer Nick Anderson:

2009-01

BE IT RESOLVED by the Big Stone County Board of Commissioners that the County Highway Engineer is hereby instructed to hire such miscellaneous and semi-skilled labor and such machinery and equipment as may from time to time be required at the prevailing rates in the community.

2009-02

BE IT RESOLVED by the Big Stone County Board of Commissioners that the County Highway Engineer is hereby authorized to purchase gravel material from various pits at the prevailing rates for graveling and re-graveling the Big Stone County roads.

2009-03

WHEREAS the Big Stone County Board of Commissioners recognizes the need to be helpful to cities and townships during an emergency or natural disaster.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Big Stone County Board of Commissioners that the County Highway Engineer is hereby authorized and instructed to pay by regular payroll up to the amount of five thousand dollars for approved emergency labor performed off the regular County Road System.

2009-04

BE IT RESOLVED by the Big Stone County Board of Commissioners that the County Highway Engineer is hereby authorized and instructed to impose weight and load restrictions as he deems necessary on any or all County Roads and County State Aid Highways pursuant to Chapter 500, Article 4, Section 1, Subdivision 3 of Laws of 1959.

2009-05

BE IT RESOLVED by the Big Stone County Board of Commissioners that the County Highway Engineer is hereby authorized to spray weeds and objectionable vegetation in all of the County Ditch Systems without further approval of the County Board of Commissioners so long as expenditures do not exceed \$750.00 for any single County Ditch. This resolution excludes Joint Ditches.

County Engineer Anderson reported that the tilling of road right-of-way will be discussed at the annual township meeting. Chairman Olson reviewed previous board action regarding this to update Commissioners Wulff and Berning.

Discussion was held on the Conservation Preservation funds and possible projects that may qualify.

Motion by Athey, seconded by Wulff and carried to authorize payment of the following claims as presented by Auditor Knutson:

Possible dates for a Joint Ditch #4 hearing were provided to Auditor Knutson. Knutson will contact Traverse County and set the hearing date.

New commissioners were informed of previous discussions regarding bonding for County projects. New bond rate information was distributed to board members for their review.

Auditor Knutson reviewed miscellaneous correspondence with board members. Following a break, elected officials John Haukos, Cindy Nelson, and Elaine Martig arrived at the meeting for the setting of elected officials' salaries. Motion by Athey and seconded by Sandberg to freeze the salaries for elected officials at the 2008 amounts for 2009 as follows:
